

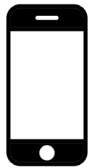

How to Apply for the Lottery

Apply online **HACLA.HCVLIST.ORG** any time between Monday, October 17 • 6:00 AM – Sunday, October 30 • 5:00 PM PDT



Applications must be submitted online through a smartphone, tablet, or computer. Applications will not be provided or accepted in person or by email, mail, or fax. **Need free internet?** Visit any Los Angeles Public Library.

To Apply for the Lottery, You Need:

- A valid email address and phone number where you can be contacted
- The full name, date of birth, and Social Security number/Alien Registration number (if you have one) for the Head of Household and their Spouse/Co-Head (if applicable)
- A current residential address (if you have one) and a mailing address
- The combined annual income for all people who will live in the household
- A pen and paper to write down your application confirmation number (optional)

Staff can answer waiting list questions or provide assistance due to disability, language translation services, or communication in an alternative format. 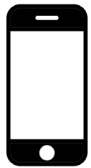
